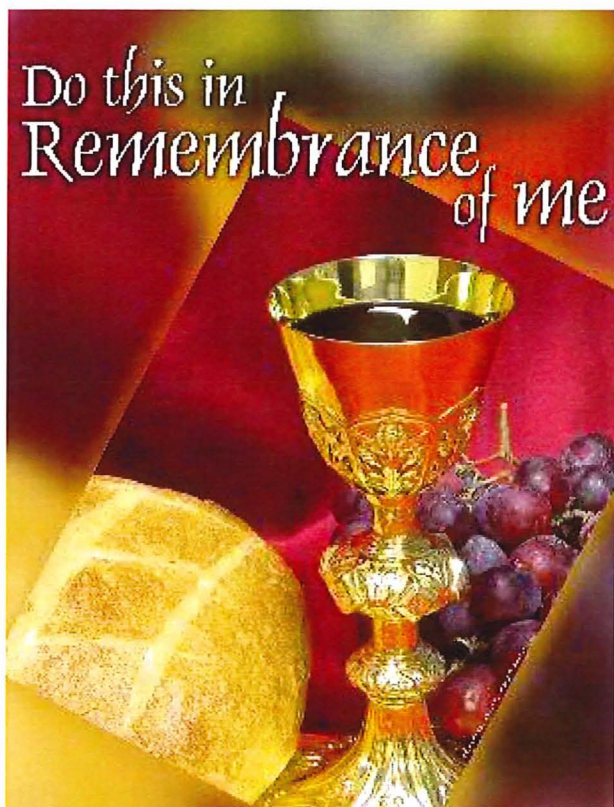

Biography for Rev. Samuel Doyle

Rev. Samuel James Doyle is a husband, father, brother, uncle, pastor and follower of the Lord Jesus Christ. He and his wife, Erika reside in Waco, Texas where he currently serves as the Senior Pastor at the Greater New Light Missionary Baptist Church. A proud graduate of Buena Vista High School in Saginaw, Michigan, Rev. Doyle was trained up to be unapologetically Christian, unashamedly African American, and an audacious advocate for education, community, and accountability.

Rev. Doyle was chosen and called by God to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ, receiving his license on January 7, 2007. As a preacher, he follows in the footsteps of his late father, Rev. Dr. Seth R. Doyle, who pastored the Historic Second Baptist Church of Bay City, Michigan for more than thirty years. While being trained at Second Baptist, Rev. Doyle served faithfully in the areas of Worship and Christian Education and Youth ministry. Moreover, he was an active minister at district and state levels, serving the Saginaw Valley Baptist District Association and the Baptist Missionary and Educational State Convention of Michigan.

Pastor Doyle received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Music from Saginaw Valley State University, and a Master of Divinity at Baylor University's George W Truett Theological Seminary in Waco, TX. He plans to continue his educational pursuits in hopes of obtaining a Doctorate.

Rev. Doyle began his tenure at the Greater New Light Baptist Church as the Executive Pastor in September of 2013. While there, he held a strong emphasis on worship, discipleship and Christian education. Among his accomplishments, he compiled a teaching manual entitled *Toward Understanding, Meaning and Application* in order to train Christian educators at Greater New Light on effective teaching practices.

In 2015, Rev. Doyle assumed the pastorate. Since taking office, he has proven to be an effective leader: reviving Wednesday night Bible Study, instituting a building campaign in order to restore their historic building and restructuring the church government to make it run effectively and efficiently for all members.

In September of 2018, Rev. Doyle began working at Mission Waco Mission World: an empowerment organization that utilizes social services and community involvement to assist people in the margins of society to improve their quality of life. There, he serves as the Director of their homeless shelter and job training program: a capacity that allows him to use his love for the community and passion for pastoral ministry to assist people in need of housing and employment.

In addition to his duties at Greater New Light and Mission Waco, Pastor Doyle has served the Baptist General Convention of Texas as a board member of the African American Fellowship and as a member of the Credentials Committee. He serves his local denominations as the 1st Vice President of the Union Baptist District Association Sunday School and BTU Congress and as a board member for Waco Regional Baptist Association. On a national level, Pastor Doyle has written for *Emmaus: a Christian apologetics blog* geared toward and created by African American ministers and scholars.

In conclusion, although he hopes to become a most distinguished preacher, pastor, and leader within his generation, Pastor Doyle's greatest joy is his family: his wife Erika and their daughters Samia and Eden.
