Dr. Corey D. B. Walker, Ph.D.

Corey D. B. Walker is Dean of Wake Forest University School of Divinity, Wake Forest Professor of the Humanities, and Inaugural Director of the Program in African American Studies at Wake Forest University. His research and teaching interests include African American philosophy, critical theory, ethics, leadership studies, religion, and public life. He is author and editor of several books and has published over seventy articles, essays, and book chapters in a wide variety of scholarly journals and publications. Dean Walker also served as Book Review Editor and Associate Editor of *The Journal of the American Academy of Religion*, generally considered the top academic journal in the field. He has lectured before academic audiences in the United States, the Caribbean and South America, Europe, and Africa. As one of the nation's distinguished scholars, the Phi Beta Kappa Society named Dean Walker the 2023-2024 Phi Beta Kappa/Frank M. Updike Memorial Visiting Scholar.

A prominent academic leader, he previously served as vice president and dean of the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology at Virginia Union University, dean of the College of Arts and Sciences and John W. and Anna Hodgin Hanes Professor of the Humanities at Winston-Salem State University, chair of the Department of Africana Studies at Brown University, and director of the Center for the Study of Local Knowledge at the University of Virginia. Dean Walker also served as a visiting professor at the Historisches Institute at Friedrich-Schiller Universität Jena in Germany, where he delivered the Johann Gustav Droysen Lecture, University of Richmond, and Union Presbyterian Seminary. He was Freedom Forum Institute Senior Fellow for Religious Freedom at the Freedom Forum Institute in Washington, DC and Non-Resident Fellow at the W.E.B. Du Bois Institute for African and African American Research at Harvard University.

Dean Walker is a graduate of Norfolk State University where he earned his bachelor's degree in finance. After a career in the financial services industry, he went on to earn his Master of Divinity degree from the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology of Virginia Union University, Master of Theological Studies degree from Harvard University, and Doctor of Philosophy degree in American studies from The College of William and Mary. He also holds the Master of Arts degree, *ad eundem*, from Brown University. An ordained American Baptist clergyperson, he speaks to congregations and communities across the nation and has appeared on a variety of media outlets in the United States and abroad.
